

Assessment and decision-making process

Eligibility assessment (staff) of each project against Creative New Zealand's eligibility criteria for Arts Grant funding – this includes general and artform specific criteria.

Assessment (staff) based on how well the project delivers to the strategic outcome selected and the credibility, accuracy and completeness of the budget

Assessment (external) based on the strength of the project for:

- the idea (what?)
- the process (how?)
- the people (who?)

Review and moderation (staff)



STAFF AND EXTERNAL ASSESSMENT RESULTS COMBINED



Preliminary recommendations (staff) on whether a project should be funded and for how much based on the combined results and the budget available for the funding round. Consideration may be given to funding priorities and whether the project has other features – innovation, community participation and cultural diversity.



Panel assessment (staff and external assessors) of preliminary recommendations and recommendations made to the Senior Manager, Arts Funding.



RECOMMENDATIONS MADE ON PROJECTS FOR FUNDING AND \$ AMOUNTS



Senior Manager – Arts Funding reviews the panel's recommendations and makes final funding decisions.



Chief Executive ratifies the funding decisions.
